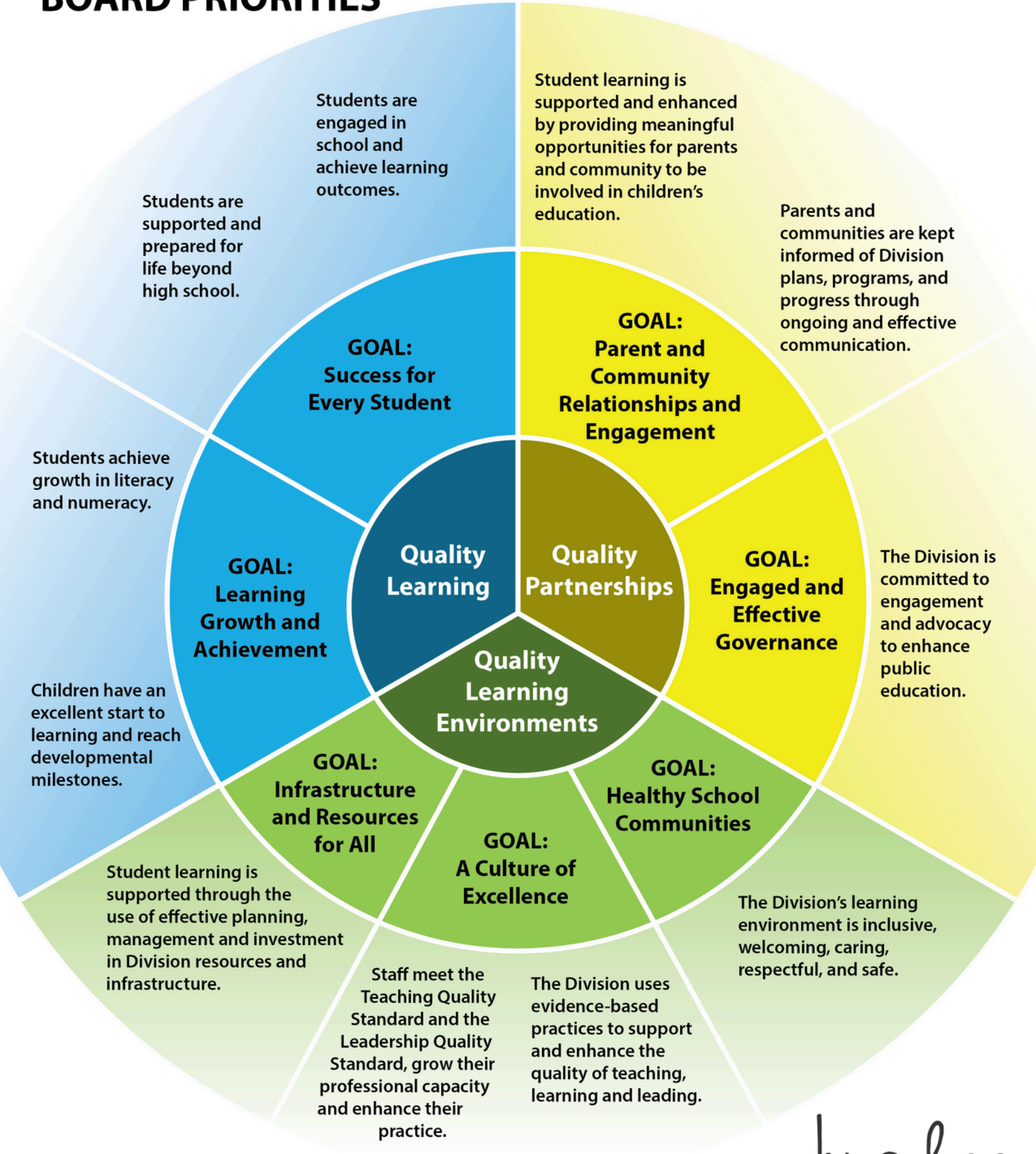


In Memory of Daniel Sloan
